1. The rates of pay listed herein are effective from the first pay period on or after **1 July 2011**.
2. This notice is to be prominently displayed in the members' Agency.
3. The rates of pay listed herein must be paid by TAB Agents who are a party to the above agreement.
4. A copy of the Enterprise Agreement should be readily available to all staff.

CONDITIONS

- (a) Casual Staff must be paid at prescribed rates for all initial training periods. The Award allows for a maximum of 12 hours at not less than 80% of the rates set down in 4 above.
- (b) Payment of Wages – Casual staff wages MUST be paid at least at regular weekly intervals.
- (c) Accidents – Casual Staff MUST report immediately to the Agent any accident causing injury to the employee, whilst travelling to and from the place of employment, or whilst at the place of employment. Failure to do so may invalidate any subsequent claim under the Workers' Compensation Act.
- (d) Higher Duties - \$2.69 per hour. Conditions relating to this payment are set out in Clause 11 of the Agreement.
- (e) Payment in lieu of a Meal Break - \$10.77. Conditions relating to this payment are set out in Clause 16 of the Agreement.
- (f) Uniform Laundry Allowance - \$1.25 per shift. Conditions relating to this payment are set out in Clause 11 of the Agreement.
